CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Mayor Shirley called the meeting to order at 7:45 p.m.

ROLL CALL

Mayor Shirley, Council Members Wicoff, Stewart, Ford, Becker, Kilby, and French were present. Also present was Administrator Slaugh, Assistant Administrator Schinstock and City Clerk Hutton.

Mayor Shirley stated that following the last council meeting he was approached by a council member desiring to have a special called meeting to discuss this topic. Mayor Shirley received a call this morning stating that if the council were to change their vote on this project he would like to have the council ask the state to do the 800 feet inside the city limits either first or last to shorten the time frame.

Motion made by Council Member Becker to continue with the project in conjunction with KDOT doing a full depth restoration on the 800 feet within the city limits as stated in the contract. Motion seconded by Council Member Stewart. All in favor. Motion carried.
