**GENERAL ORDINANCE 3418**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF IOLA, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF IOLA, KANSAS:


SECTION 1: A Capital Improvement Program is hereby established as a means of planning for required improvements to the infrastructure of the City of Iola and reserving funds for the improvements.

SECTION 2: Iola Municipal Code, Chapter 2 Administration, is hereby amended to add section 2-177 Capital Improvement Program. Said section shall read: The Capital Improvement Program (CIP) will be prepared and reviewed annually during the budgeting process. The CIP will be adopted by reference. Placing items on the CIP does not imply that there are funds available to complete the projects. The list is a projection of what is desired. The plan will be adjusted as funds become available or priorities change.


SECTION 3: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
