GENERAL ORDINANCE 3461

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF IOLA ADOPTING A VACATION OF ROAD AND ALLEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF IOLA, KANSAS:

Section 1: The City Council has hereby adopted a change to vacate the roads and alley for the following described property:






