**GENERAL ORDINANCE 3463**

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF IOLA VACATING A PORTION OF A ROAD OR ALLEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF IOLA, KANSAS:


Section 1: The City Council hereby adopts a change to vacate the U-shaped driveway for the following described property:

**All of the U-shaped driveway that extends from First Street and surrounds Lot 25 Richard's Place Addition to the City of Iola which is also referred to as Richard Place Addition.**

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iola Register as provided by law.


