

Ordinance No. 3465 Summary

Ordinance 3465 is the third portion of a major review of the entire Municipal Code book. Language has been modified to clarify intent and obsolete sections removed. "City commission" has been replaced with "city council" or "governing body" to reflect changes in form of government implemented in 2011. Court costs have been increased from \$60.00 to \$75.00.

GENERAL ORDINANCE 3465

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MULTIPLE SECTIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF IOLA, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF IOLA, KANSAS THAT THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS OF THE IOLA MUNICIPAL CODE ARE AMENDED OR NEW SECTIONS ADDED AS NOTED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following chapters or sections have been added, amended, or deleted to read as follows:

Change "city commission" to "city council" or "governing body" as appropriate – 299 instances in Municipal Code. In accordance with Kansas Statutes most references to "city commission" in Chapter 106 were changed to "governing body" and in other portions of the Code "city commission" was changed to "city council."

Sec. 1-2. - Rules of construction and definitions.

Governing body. The term "governing body" shall mean the mayor and city council members charged with governing the affairs of the city.

Sec. 2-31. - Meetings.

(b) Special meetings may be called by the mayor or acting mayor on the written request of any three members of the council, specifying the object and purpose of the meeting and entered at length in the journal. (K.S.A. 14-111)

Sec. 2-67. - Oath of office.

The mayor, city council and all officers, before entering upon the duties of their respective offices, shall take and subscribe an oath or affirmation as follows:

Article IV. Building Trades Board

Sections 14-151 to 14-156 deleted.

The building trades board has not been in operation for approximately ten years and is no longer considered essential. It is therefore abolished. The function of the board has been replaced by adoption of the International Building Codes and utilizing licensed building trade professionals.

Section 26-34. Court fines.

(b) Court costs of \$75.00 shall be added to **all** misdemeanor code violations, infractions and traffic violations fines, except for parking (88, 89, and 97).

Section 34-800. Allen County Ambulance Service.


Section deleted. The additional \$5.00 per month fee for ambulance service expired December 31, 2014.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
