GENERAL ORDINANCE 3469

AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER 66, SECTION 3 TO THE CODE OF THE CITY OF IOLA, RELATING TO TOBACCO USE IN RIVERSIDE PARK

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF IOLA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. The City does hereby add Section 66-3, Chapter 66 of the Code of the City of Iola, to read as follows:

Sec. 66-3. Riverside Park; Use of Tobacco Products.

Use of tobacco products in Riverside Park is limited to designated areas. Signs mark the designated areas. Anyone desiring to smoke or use smokeless tobacco products is required to use such products in the designated areas, as marked.


SECTION 8. REPEAL. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed accordingly.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage and publication as provided by law, with the implementation date of February 1, 2017.


