On February 13, 2017, the City of Iola, Kansas adopted Ordinance 3471 amending Chapter 14, Section 14-30 in the Code of the City of Iola, changing the energy efficiency standards to the International Energy Conservation Code, 2006 edition, on or after March 1, 2017.

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GENERAL ORDINANCE 3471

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE II, SECTION 14-30 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF IOLA, RELATING TO ENERGY EFFICIENCY STANDARDS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF IOLA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. The City does hereby amend Section 14-30 of Article II, Chapter 14 of the Code of the City of Iola, to read as follows:

Sec. 14-30. - Energy efficiency standards.

- a) [Adoption.] Certain documents, three copies of which are on file and are open for inspection of the public in the office of code services are marked and designated as the International Energy Conservation Code, 2006 edition, published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Energy Conservation Code of the City of Iola, in the State of Kansas for regulating and governing energy efficient building envelopes and installation of energy efficient mechanical, lighting and power systems as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Energy Conservation Code on file in the office of the City of Iola are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this legislation, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in section 14-30.1 of this article.
- b) Certificate of compliance. No certificate of occupancy will be issued to a new residential dwelling or new commercial building until the code services officer has received a certificate of compliance from the owner that the residential dwelling or commercial building meets the standards set forth in International Energy Conservation Code. Such certificate of compliance shall include supporting statements from the architect and/or contractor, if either or both such persons were employed in the design and construction of the new residential dwelling or new commercial building. Receipt by the city of such certificate of compliance shall be required for permanent utility service.

SECTION 8. REPEAL. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed accordingly.


SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force for billings on or after March 1, 2017.
