On June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2017, the City of Iola, Kansas adopted Ordinance 3475 repealing Ordinance 3403, which was originally passed April 9, 2012. This repeal removes the purchasing policy from the Iola Municipal Code and is effective July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017.

**GENERAL ORDINANCE 3475**

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 3403, WHICH AMENDED CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 4, SECTION 2-116 OF THE CODE FOR THE CITY OF IOLA, RELATING THE PURCHASING POLICY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF IOLA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. REPEAL. The City does hereby Ordinance 3403 and removes Chapter 2, Article 4, Section 2-116 from the Code of the City of Iola.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage and publication as provided by law, with the implementation date of July 1, 2017.
