Reserve-A-Truck Operation Rules

The purpose of the Reserve-A-Truck program is to provide the City's current residential customers with an additional means of disposing of large accumulations of trash.

Program Highlights:

- FREE and available to city residential customers only
Runs March thru November
 - City has 2 trucks which may be reserved for any given weekend except Holidays, before City Wide Clean up
 - Only one truck per person
 - Available on weekends only
 - The City reserves the right to cancel the Reserve-A-Truck contract with-out notice at the City's discretion. The program will be suspended for several weeks in the summer while city employees seal streets, and the weekend before City Wide Clean Up. Winter weather conditions may cause the program to be canceled for a short time.

How the program works:

- Call the City Administrator's Office at (620) 365-4900 to reserve a date. A Letter of Agreement will need to be signed, the Thursday before, with your name, address and parking instructions for the truck.
- The Street & Alley Department will deliver the truck to the address on the agreement letter by 4:00 p.m. Friday afternoon. The tailgate will remain in the upright position at all times.
- The cab of the truck will be locked, thus the truck will not be moved after it is parked.
- The truck will be loaded so as to permit safe transportation to the landfill without stacking or adjusting of the load by the City's driver.
- Street & Alley will pick up the truck by 8:30 a.m. on Monday morning and transport debris to the landfill.



Items not allowed:

No hazardous or toxic materials will be hauled, including vehicle batteries, asbestos, liquid wastes or tires. No contractors materials.

Material Options:

- Brush, limbs or unbagged leaves
- Household trash or bagged leaves
 - Wood, lumber, or shingles

Only one material option per Truck

NOTE:

Except in cases of extraordinary need, individual citizens may not reserve a truck more frequently than every three months.

Failure to adhere to the rules or if the loaded truck reveals items or materials that are not permitted at the landfill, eligibility for future use of the Reserve-A-Truck will be eliminated with a possible fine will be imposed.
