Founded in 1859, Iola is the County Seat of Allen County, and is nestled between the Flint Hills to the west and the Ozarks to the southeast. Its centralized location within southeast Kansas makes Iola an ideal place to live, work, and play.

The Prairie Spirit Trail

A 51 mile trail that runs along a rail bed between lola and Ottawa with 1+ miles of the trail running through lola city limits, connecting with the Southwind Rail Trail near Riverside Park.

The Southwind Rail Trail

A 6.5 mile walking and biking trail that connects the communities of Humboldt and lola.

The Lehigh Portland Trails

With 10+ miles of trails for hiking, running, and mountain biking with beautiful views. lola has one of the most diversified and largest trail systems in the state, giving it the name "King of Trails".
