*The pool will open on Monday, May 30<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 PM. Adult swim hours will begin on May 31<sup>st</sup>.*

**Full Season Passes** will be available for purchase at the Recreation Office May 9-July 1. Passes will not be sold at the pool. Good for dates May 30-August 7.

Individual Pass (Ages 6-54) \$65.00    Individual Pass (Ages 55-64) \$55.00

Family Pass \$140.00 for 4 members, additional \$20.00 per member after 4, for immediate family members only.

**Discount Admission Tickets** will be available for purchase at the Recreation Office through August 5. Tickets will not be sold at the pool. 10 Tickets for \$15.00

**Daily Door Admission:** Ages 5 & Under, Free, must be accompanied by an adult. Ages 65 & Older, Free.  
Open Swim, Ages 6-64, \$2.00. Night Swim, Ages 6-64, \$1.00.

**Pool Hours:** Adult Swim – Mon.-Fri. 12:00-1:00 PM; Mon.-Thur. 5:30-6:30 PM  
Open Swim – Sun. 1:00-6:00 PM; Mon.-Thur. 1:00-5:30 PM; Fri. & Sat. 1:00-7:00 PM  
Night Swim – Mon.-Thur. 6:30-8:00 PM

**Anyone who** enters the pool facility must pay the appropriate admission fee, even if they aren't planning on swimming in the pool. Cash only, no checks or credit cards will be accepted for an admission fee.

**Once a patron** has paid the admission fee or entered the pool facility with a Discount Ticket and then leaves the facility for any reason, they must pay the appropriate admission fee or use another Ticket to re-enter the facility.

**Pool Closing Policy:** the Iola Pool will not open due to inclement weather or if the outside temperature is below 70 degrees. If the pool has opened and the temperature drops below 70 degrees, the pool will close.

**There will be** a couple of Wednesdays throughout the season where we will host a home swim meet and the pool will close at 4:00 PM to the public, those dates will be announced soon. On July 4 the pool will close at 6:00 PM.

**Pool parties** may be scheduled for a Friday or Saturday evening when available, from 7:00-9:00 PM. The cost is \$200.00 and must be scheduled through the Recreation Office. Please call 620-365-4990 after May 9 to reserve.

*The Iola Municipal Pool will close August 7<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 PM for the season.*

**2022 Iola Municipal Swimming Pool Rules** \*Proper swimwear must be worn. Street clothes, jeans, cut-offs, gym clothes, casual shorts & thongs are not allowed in the pools or on the slides. \*No person having any infectious disease or infection will be allowed into the swimming pool area. The manager will make final judgment. \*Children who wear diapers must wear swim diapers in the pool. Swim diapers are available for purchase at the entrance window. *(Please remember that we have a family restroom for mothers with small children.)* \*Concession stand items must be consumed within & are restricted to the designated concession area. *(No outside food or drink allowed.)* \*No alcoholic beverages or tobacco products will be permitted within the pool area. Any patron found with alcoholic beverages or using tobacco products will be asked to leave the premises. \*No one over 6 years of age allowed in the toddler pool. Children using the toddler pool must be accompanied by a guardian at least 16 years of age. \*Patrons unable to demonstrate ability to swim will not be permitted in the deep water, known as the 12 ft. area. A lifeguard on duty will make final judgment. \*Diving board rules must be observed at all times. Only one person is allowed on the board at a time with only one bounce before diving. Dive only when the landing area is clear. Dive straight off the board and swim immediately to a ladder. No Goggles or eyewear allowed. \*Water slide rules will be strictly enforced including age and height restrictions. No swimsuits with metal decorations or rivets will be allowed on the slides. *(All riders must be 48" tall. Only one rider at a time. Please read complete list of rules located by the entrance gate to the slides.)* \*Courtesy is expected of all patrons. Inappropriate language will not be tolerated. No running on the pool deck. No horseplay in the pool or on the pool deck and ladders. No public displays of affection. Pick up & dispose of litter. Please respect the property of others. \*Patrons must obey the directives of the pool staff at all times. Patrons failing to follow rules or directives are subject to eviction & suspension from the premises. \*City of Iola & pool staff are not responsible for lost or stolen property. Patrons are advised to provide locks when using lockers. (When using the lockers, you must provide your own lock. Locks must be removed at closing time. If any lock remains on a locker at closing time, the lock will be cut & items removed.)
