GENERAL ORDINANCE 3528

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF IOLA ADOPTING A CHANGE OF ZONING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF IOLA, KANSAS:

Section 1: The City Council has hereby adopted a change of zoning from R-1 (Single-Family Residential) to C-2 (General Business) for the following described property:




